Application Used: Book Creator

Resources: 15 iPad minis, interactive whiteboard or projector, iPad to VGA connector, spare paper for storyboarding.

Topic: CREATIVE MULTIMEDIA – Creating presentations combining a variety of information and media

Overview:

To learn how to use the Book Creator app / consider comic genre and how it can be replicated using the Book Creator app (To create a presentation for a specific audience)

Week 3

Learning Objectives:

- To select relevant designs and begin to explain choices
- To create a presentation combining a variety of information and media

Learning Outcomes:

- Students will have been introduced to the Book Creator app and had the opportunity to continue / finish creating a Minecraft comic.

LESSON OUTLINE

Starter input / activity (15 min)

With the teacher's iPad playing through the projector, the teacher recaps the comic settings covered in the previous lesson. If possible it would also be useful to share and compare examples of real comics brought in by the teacher and / or pupils.

Teacher can also use this time to address any issues regarding the app that were not brought up during the last lesson's plenary session.

Activity –Minecraft Comic (35 min)

Students use the skills learnt to continue developing their comic based on a Minecraft theme.

Most groups should be ready to start putting their comics together at the start of this activity time. If groups have not quite collected all of their images, they should still be encouraged to start their comic. They can collect the rest of their images if time remains at the end of the lesson.

Emphasise to pupils that they should have some finished pages by the end of the lesson.

Plenary / Reinforcement (5-10 min at end)

Each pair should team up with another pair in class to share and comment on their Minecraft comics.

Differentiation and Extension

More confident pupils should work with those who require support.

More able pupils could use the 'edit' features within the photo app to remove Minecraft UI.

Less able pupils could add their own recorded clips to their speech bubbles rather than typing what has been said in each case.
